We continue to support Orton Longueville Parish Church with church maintenance and have also contributed to clearance of more ground for extra burial space. Botolph Green Residents' Association continues to receive a grant for their annual Festival on the Green and we have also funded extra grass cutting for them.

We have assisted Bifield Residents' Association with funding for their new garden at their sheltered scheme. Orton Silver Tops were given a grant to assist them with increased rent and enable the group to keep providing their service.

Orton Park Cricket Club now have their complete Pavilion and have started their new season. The new lease is still ongoing, but it is hoped that this will be complete shortly.

I would like to thank Councillor Casey in this role of Chair over the year and I would sincerely like to thank our Clerk, Alison for all her hard work during the year.
